This training will be hands-on with all participants getting in the water to learn techniques for biological, physical and chemical water quality monitoring. This is an entry level training intended for participants who desire basic water quality information. **Level 1** was designed with educators in mind and may be appropriate for Soil & Water Conservation Districts, Park Districts, Health Departments, or anyone with an interest in Ohio water quality. The purpose of Level 1 is primarily to promote public awareness and education about surface waters of the state.

Approval of Level 1 QCD will be automatic by the Ohio EPA after completion of this workshop. The Scioto SWCD will be our local hosts.
